

UNISCAPE organises the second edition of the International Photo Contest People's Landscapes, open to all students of European Universities from 18 to 35 years old.

The aim of the contest is to encourage students to observe landscapes through the eyes of people in order to express how each one of us sees and perceives our landscapes by capturing the soul and the transitory identity of places, in particular of the degraded and everyday landscapes.

Participation

The participation to the contest is open to all students (undergraduates, Master and PhD students) from 18 to 35 years old attending any pan-European University or any International University study abroad program based in Europe. Each student can participate with a maximum of three digital images in color or in black and white.

The images must regard landscape as it is meant by the European Landscape Convention; therefore they may concern natural, rural, urban and peri-urban areas, including inland water and marine areas, but also those landscapes that might be considered outstanding as well as everyday or degraded landscapes.

The images must reflect the point of view of the observer with regard to the represented landscape and prove the importance and the influence of the place on the observer himself.

For this edition the contest is divided into three sections:

- Urban landscapes
- Idyllic landscapes
- Landscape photography as social criticism

The deadline for submitting entries is the **15 of May 2011** by sending the images and the required documents to the e-mail: peopleslandscapes@uniscape.eu

Award

The images will become part of UNISCAPE's photographic archive and can be used for any activity under the auspices of UNISCAPE.

The winner of each section will be awarded with a 300 euro prize and his/her images will be published on UNISCAPE's website.
